
What is Dynamic View?

Dynamic View is a premium app that allows users to collaborate on a single set of data while maintaining confidentiality of specific fields.

Enables users to:

- Selectively share elements of work
- Establish logic to determine what can be seen/edited







Dynamic View uses include the following:

- <u>Finance</u> Accounts payable management
- <u>IT</u> Ticketing/request tracking
- Marketing Creative services requests
- Operations Engineering request management
- HR Performance reviews
- Supply Chain Vendor management



Who interacts with Dynamic View?

Administrators


- Configure views
- Establish logic to determine which fields can be seen/edited by specific users
- Must be shared to source sheet(s)/report(s)

Others who view/edit data

- Can view and/or source data (access determined by permissions set by admin)
- Do not need to be shared to source



First scenario: employee reviews





What is a view?

This is what gets configured in Dynamic View to allow users to collaborate on selected fields.

In this scenario we need:

- A view for employees
- A view for managers
- Neither group will be shared to the sheet
